Why this training?

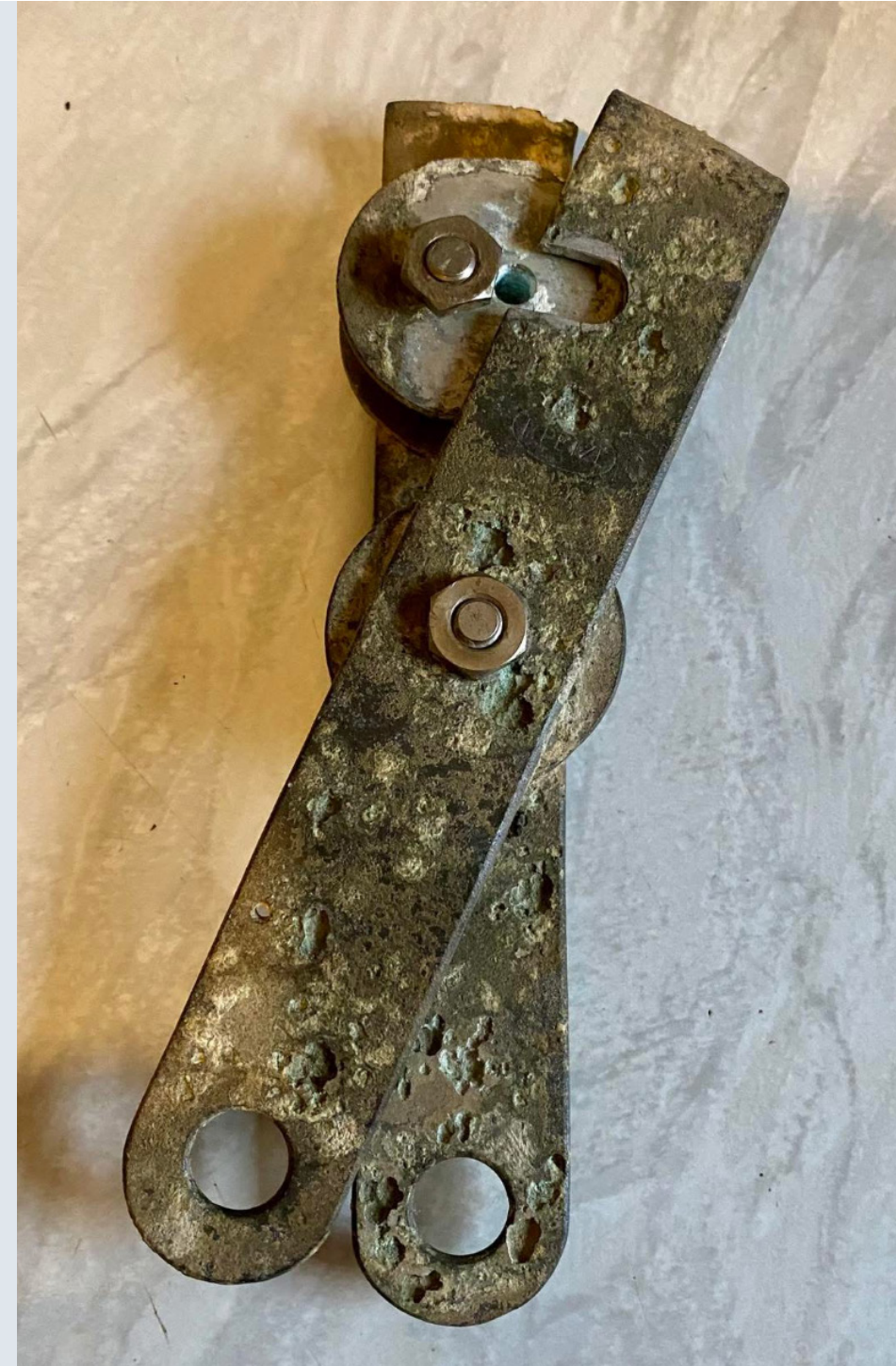
